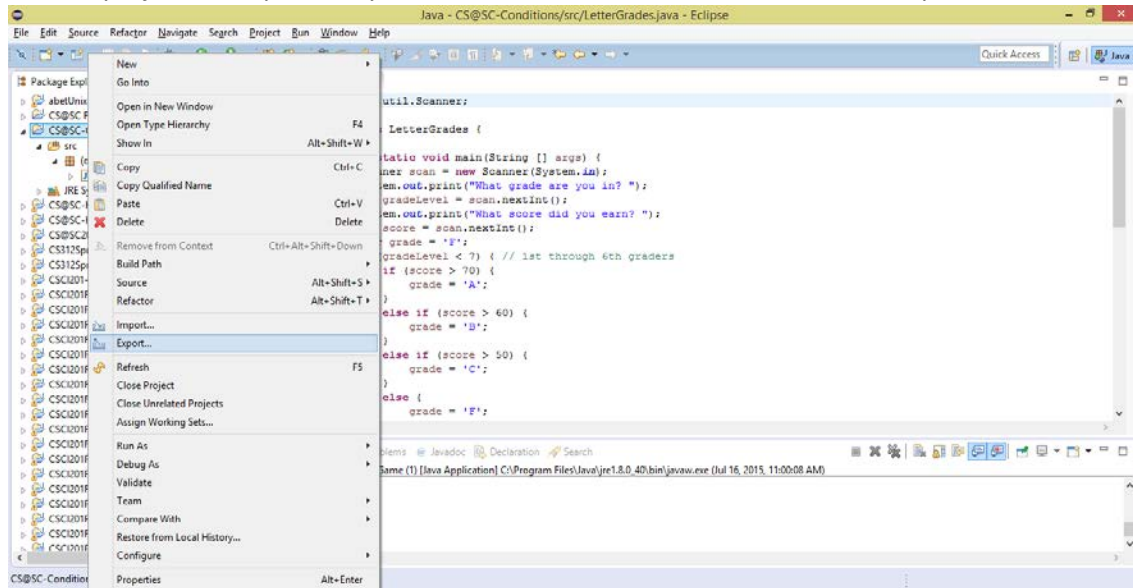


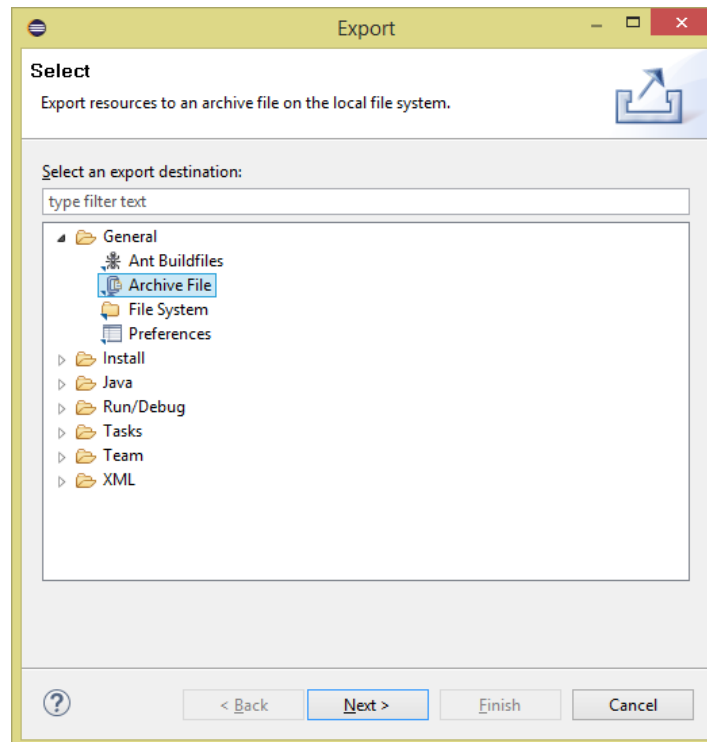
Exporting a Project from Eclipse Prepared by Prof. Jeffrey Miller

Exporting Project

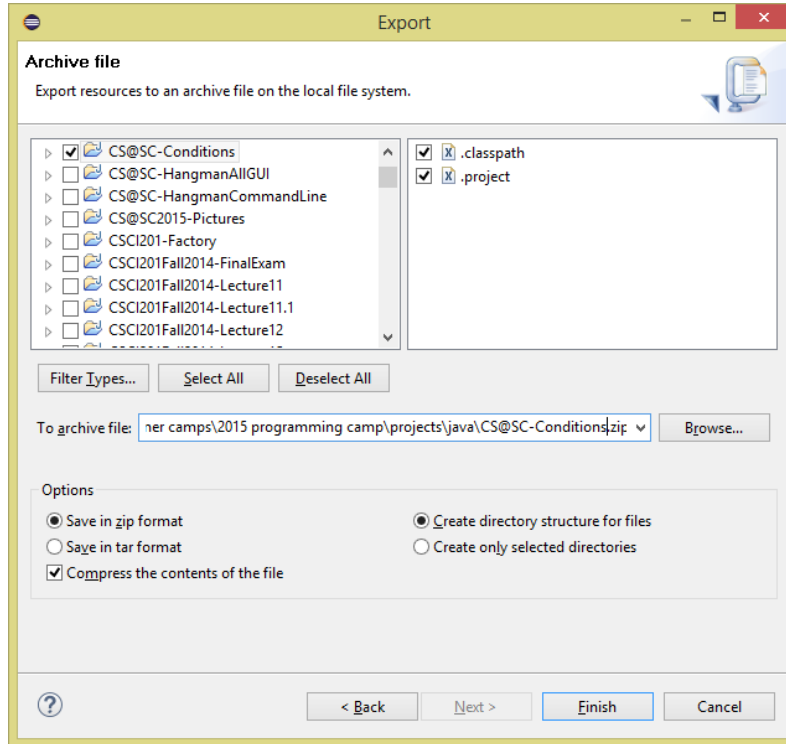
To send a project to the CS@SC Summer Camps, you will need to export your entire project so that we are able to import it back into Eclipse and test your program. To export a project, right-click on the name of the project in Eclipse that you would like to send to us and select the “Export...” menu item.



Under General, select the “Archive File” menu item and click the “Next” button.



Make sure your project is checked on the next screen and select a location to save the file in the “To archive file” text field. You can click the “Browse” button and select an appropriate directory. NOTE: Make sure you remember this location since that is where the exported project will be placed. Make sure “Save in zip format” and “Create directory structure for files” are both selected, along with “Compress the contents of the file.” Click the “Finish” button.



The above window disappears when you select the “Finish” button. You then need to open up the file explorer in Windows to find where you placed your exported project. Navigate to the directory and find your exported project, which will be a zip file. This file will be what you will send to the CS@SC Summer Camps staff.
